- Perspex Frost Cast Acrylic Sheets allow 60% transmission of light and give a modern and contemporary feel. The frosted surface is resistant to surface scratching and marks and even after thermoforming it keeps the frosted texture.
- Perspex Cast Acrylic is the original thermoplastic material, manufactured in the UK since 1933 and trademarked in 1934.
- Frosted smooth finish on both sides protected by an easy peel film.
- Perspex is one of the hardest thermoplastics on the market and remains aesthetically attractive for much longer than many other plastic sheet products.
- Perspex is very versatile and ideal for being laser cut, drilled, thermoformed, polished, drape formed and also used with a hot and cold line bender.
- Excellent resistance to outdoor weathering with a 10 year guarantee from Perspex. No significant change in visual appearance or physical performance will take place during this 10 year period.
- The environmental credentials of Perspex mean that it is an efficiently produced, non-toxic pure material with a long service life and can also be recycled all the way back to the original raw material monomer – regardless of colour.
- High tensile strength and rigidity so Perspex is ideal for applications where surfaces that are resistant to bending or deformation are required.
- Perspex Sheet achieves a Class 3 Fire Rating.
- Perspex has good resistance to impact and is recognised as a safety glazing material meeting the requirements of ANSI Z.97 and BS 6262.
- Perspex is lightweight and is half the weight of an equivalent glass panel so is more easily transported, installed and supported.
